A GUIDE TO RECYCLING IN LEWISBURG

The City of Lewisburg offers free, curbside recycling for all City residents and businesses. Curbside recycling includes aluminum, # 1 and # 2 plastic only, steel "tin" cans, newspaper, computer paper, magazines, cardboard and electronic devices. Bags for plastic (yellow) and aluminum (orange) recyclables as well as recycling brochures are available at City Hall and the Public Works Office.

Recyclable materials are picked up the first full week (Monday-Friday) of each month and the third week of the month on customer's regular trash collection day. If a holiday falls on a Monday during recycling week, recyclable materials are picked up one day later (i.e., Monday pickup is on Tuesday, Tuesday pickup is on Wednesday, etc.). When a holiday falls within the workweek, Thursday customers are picked up on Friday along with Friday customers.

As a reminder aluminum cans must be clean and steel "tin" cans and plastic jugs/containers need to be rinsed out. Newspaper & computer paper should be clean, dry and placed in grocery bags or securely tied in bundles with twine around each side (no wire please). Magazines must be removed from plastic wrap, and cardboard inserts must be removed. Clean dry magazines may be placed in grocery bags or securely tied in bundles with twine around each side (no wire please). Cardboard should be clean, dry and securely tied in bundles with twine around both sides (no wire please). Corrugated cardboard boxes need to be flattened. Cereal boxes need to have inside liners removed and be flattened.

No type of plastic grocery bags or any type of Styrofoam is allowed.
